

NSDFPA AWARD FOR ROTC STUDENTS IN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

- 1. DESCRIPTION:** The Award consists of a GOLD pendant and a ribbon bar.
Note: the ribbon is worn with the red field to the wearer's right.

- 2. PURPOSE:** The purpose of the National Society Daughters of Founders and Patriots of America Award is to recognize a qualified cadet at institutions hosting the ROTC program.

- 3. ELIGIBILITY:** The cadet must:
 - (a) Be in the upper 10% of the class.
 - (b) Have demonstrated qualities of dependability, good character, adherence to military discipline, leadership potential, patriotism and an understanding of the importance of American Heritage.

- 4. ADMINISTRATION:**
 - (a) The recipient shall be selected by the detachment commander annually.
 - (b) Medals may be requested in advance of the choice of the recipient.
Requests from detachment commanders may be sent to the state chapters, NSDFPA, where the program has been adopted. In the event there is no state chapter, medals may be requested from the National Chairman, Military Education Committee.

- 5. PRESENTATION:** Presentation of the award shall be made by the Chapter President, the Military Education Chairman or a designated representative. If a member of the National Society of the Daughters of Founders and Patriots of America cannot be present, the detachment commander shall appoint someone to make the presentation.

- 6. REPORT TO DONOR:** A report of the presentation ceremony, the name of the Recipient, and a list of his/her qualifications shall be sent to the donor.
